



## **CACFP: Hunger Relief Partner Commitments**

### Commitment to Food Safety

Each type of meal available has certain site requirements related to quantity, storage, service and food safety. Each site director must sign the Three O'clock Project daily operating procedure annually.

### Commitment to Monitoring Requirements

All partnering sites must comply with requirements to monitor the use of CACFP meals during meal distribution. As a part of your training and application process, you agree to diligently complete all required paperwork during time of meal service and follow partnership protocols with TOP to send all documentation to a designated TOP representative as outlined in your partnership agreement.

### Commitment to Low Waste

As a partner with TOP, you are committing to timely enrollment updates throughout the 2021-2022 CACFP program with a designated TOP representative. This enrollment information supports our commitment to reduce waste of unserved meals throughout the duration of the program. As a partner, you are committing to a shared cost structure for excessive waste to share the responsibility of being mindful consumers.
